The studio focussed upon creating a vital housing colony accommodating the living and working activities of a diverse group of inhabitants, located at the threshold between farmland and new development in Greenville, South Carolina. Located at the center of the Atlanta-Charlotte corridor, the colony was envisioned as a living system cultivating a larger network of live-work communities along this rapidly developing axis.
